WHEREAS, Alzheimer's Tennessee is a statewide, independent 501c3 not-for-profit organization, based in Tennessee since 1983, that provides support services to our citizens, promotes brain health through education, and champions global research for better prevention and treatment strategies; and

WHEREAS, The State Court Clerks Association of Tennessee voted to adopt and support Alzheimer's Tennessee to help full fulfill the organization's vision to Make Alzheimer's a Memory; and
